



Attention KOP residents and commuters that travel around Moore Road:

A notice was distributed the week of March 27th by Aqua Pennsylvania (Aqua) informing property owners and businesses around Moore Rd. that the company will be replacing the existing 12-inch cast iron water main on the following streets in Upper Merion Township:

- Moore Rd. between First Ave. and Old Valley Forge Rd.
- Rogers Rd. between Moore Rd. and end of cul-de-sac

The project is scheduled to begin the week of April 3, 2017 with the installation of 4,475 feet of 12-inch ductile iron pipe, with completion expected in June. Construction will typically take place weekdays, 7 AM-4 PM. Access will be provided for emergency, mail and trash services. Residents will have access to their properties, but at times will need to enter from different directions due to changing work zones. Aqua will notify customers 24 hours in advance of any scheduled shutdown. However, as with any construction project, an emergency shutdown might be necessary. If so, Aqua will restore service as soon as possible.

Construction in the road will require a lane closure at times but Aqua does not anticipate closing the road to traffic in either direction. KOP-BID will pass along any updates that we receive on the project.
